House Bill 7 (HB 7) adds new material that creates the Opportunity Enterprise Act in Public Finance; authorizes the New Mexico Finance Authority to provide for and establish terms for financing, loans and leases; creates the Opportunity Enterprise Revolving Fund; transfers excess revenue to the General Fund; creates and provides powers and duties for the Opportunity Enterprise Review Board; and requires reports.

HB 70 relates telecommunications by amending the Rural Telecommunications Act of New Mexico, raising the CAP for obligations on the State Rural Universal Service Fund, raising the Service Fund to forty million dollars (\$40,000) per year for the years 2022, 2023, and 2024, authorizing the Public Regulation Commission to spend seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for audits or evaluations of results of certain expenditures from the State Rural Universal Service Fund.
